Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on January 11th 2018 at 6:00pm. Present were; Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby and Ben Cline. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Attorney Ed Buchanan were also present. There were no visitors attending.

Acting Mayor Tremain called the meeting to order at 6:03pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes as read. Ben seconded, motion carried. There was no old business.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Ben Cline offered to attend the WAM Conference in Cheyenne in February. Mike Huseby moved to approve the renewal of the lease agreement for Natalie Clayton-Smart Start Preschool. Ben seconded, motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed, Mike Huseby moved to approve a fifty cent raise to the LHS Janitor position. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. No other motions were made. Joel moved to pay the bills, Ben seconded, motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:04pm.
