Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on March 21st 2019 at 7:00pm. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard; Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Attorney Ed Buchanan were also present. Visitor attending was Marlon Giese.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried.

Marlon Giese came to discuss his building permit. After discussion, no motions were made.
