Minutes from July Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on July 11th 2019 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Kirk Haas, Ben Cline, Mike Meysenburg and Mike Huseby; Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Clerk Cathy Stoddard. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. Visitors attending were Daisy Justus and Liam Haas.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm. Mike Huseby moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk Haas seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for visitor comments or questions. No comments at the time.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave an update on electronic speed signs.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Tracy gave an update on the sewer project, the project should go out for bids in August. The amendment to fiscal year 18-19 budget was discussed. Kirk moved to approve Resolution #5-19 ~ Amendment to Fiscal Year 18-19 Budget. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried. Public works and clerk questions were discussed. Tracy discussed the landfill monitoring process and the results of the last tests. He also discussed the fire truck project. The project should go out to bid in a couple weeks pending approval of USDA and SLIB. Daisy Justus stated her concern for the property next to her and asked if the council knew the plans for the property. After further discussion, no motions were made. Cathy stated the MOU for the Giese property had been signed. After a brief discussion, Mike Meysenburg moved to waive \$102 of the \$750 fine. Ben seconded, Kirk abstained, motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to pay the bills, Kirk seconded, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:22pm.
