Minutes from July Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on July 9th 2020 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Kirk Haas, Mike Meysenburg; Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard; Attorney Ed Buchanan and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell. Councilman, Mike Huseby was absent. Visitors attending were Diane Humphrey, Susan Hunter, Stacie McDonald and Greg Worthen.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:17 pm. Kirk moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried.

Greg Worthen from Visionary came to discuss their progress for availability of service in LaGrange. He also entertained the idea of a lease agreement with the town for addition service opportunities. After a lengthy discussion, Kirk moved to have the lease agreement reviewed by the town attorney and after reviewed and all corrections are made, approve the lease with Visionary for equipment to be placed at the LaGrange Heritage Square and on the Water Tower.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Sewer and water permit withdrawal was discussed. There was no response to the letter sent in June and no motions were made. The 1st phase of the concrete project is complete. The lagoon project is coming along well and should be complete by the end of August if not sooner. The 2nd phase Walk Path project was discussed and the application will be submitted by July 15th 2020.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Diane Humphrey was sworn in as the newly appointed councilmember and will fill the vacant seat until the May 2021 elections. After a brief discussion, Mike Meysenburg moved to approve Resolution #3-20 Amending FY19-20 Budget Kirk seconded, motion carried. Clerk & public works questions were discussed. Diane moved to pay the bills; Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourn at 8:53pm.



Public works is still cleaning water valve boxes and meter pits. The water study is in progress and as soon as all the information is gathered the holes will be filled in. PLEASE be patient with the process and PLEASE watch for the holes. The town has placed large florescent green cones over these areas but unfortunately, the cones are getting stolen and we are doing the best we can to keep the areas marked.
