Minutes from November Town Council Meeting

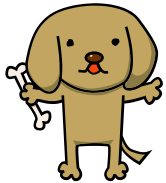
Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on November 9th 2017 at 6:00pm. Present were; Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby and Ben Cline. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. There were no visitors attending.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:12pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes as read. Ben seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Mike Huseby moved to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #65 Animal Control-Dogs. Joel seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Clerk and public works questions were discussed, Mike Huseby moved to approve resolution #4-17 adopting the Wyoming Region 7 Hazard Mitigation Plan. Joel seconded, motion carried. The Christmas lighting contest was discussed and information will go out in the December newsletter. Joel moved to pay the bills, Ben seconded, motion carried. Joel moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:12pm.

Reminder

Per Ordinance #31, Dog Tags Are Due January 1, 2018

Proof of rabies shots is required. Please get your animal to the vet, if needed, for their rabies shots before January 1st. **A \$50 fine will be charged to those who do not purchase dog tags by January 1st.**
The current rate is \$15.00 for any dog, spayed or not. If you own a dog in the city limits, be sure to stop by the Town Hall and purchase your dog tags before January 1st, NO EXCEPTIONS!
A copy of the ordinance is available at the Town Hall.

Town Ordinance #31 requires anyone having a dog in town limits to purchase an annual dog license.

The new Ordinance #65 passed at the November meeting increases the fine to **\$50** per dog for not getting your dog tag by the January 1st deadline.

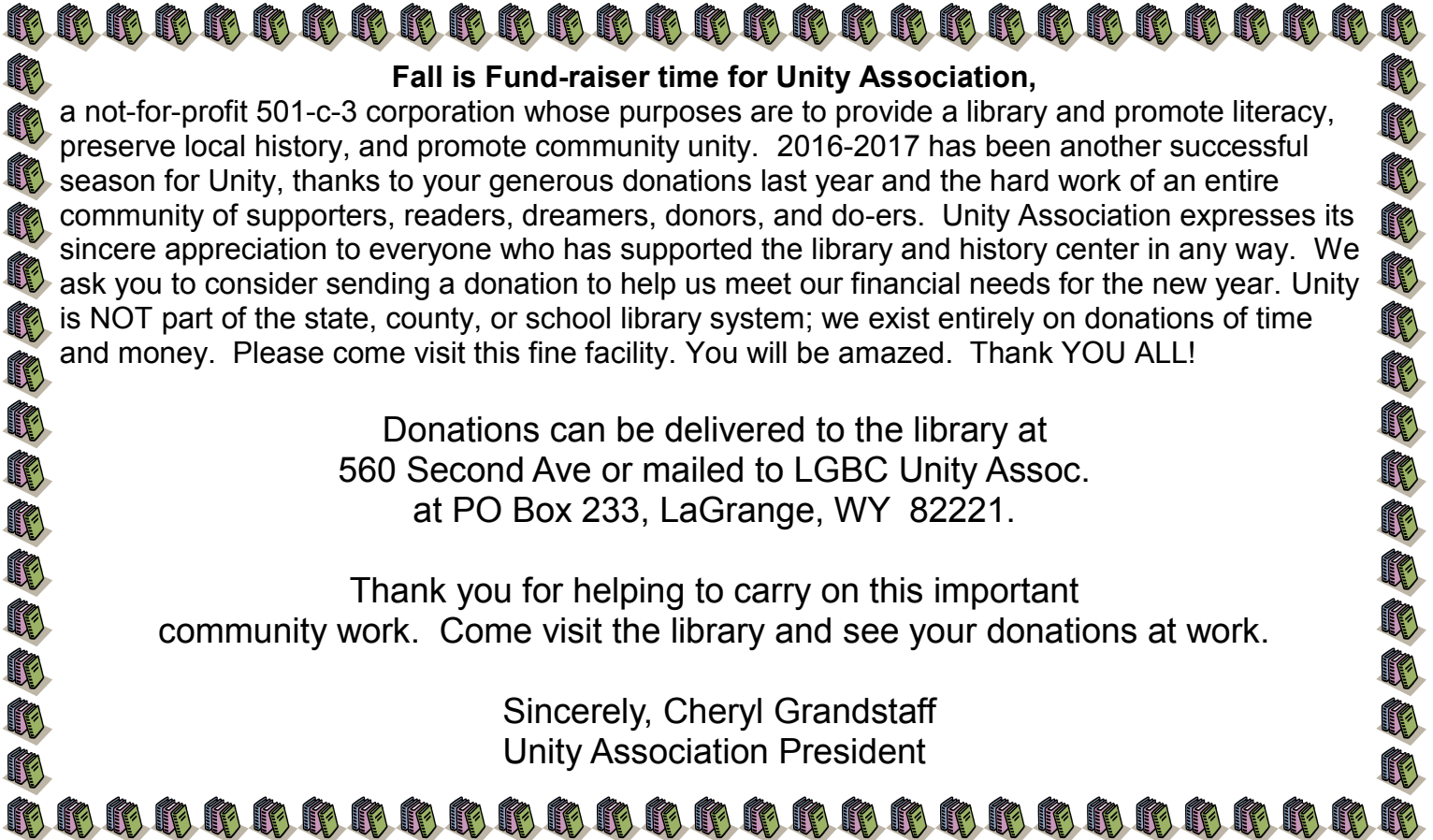

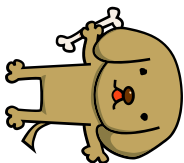

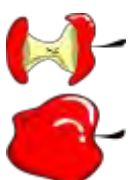
