Minutes from November Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on November 11th 2021 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby, Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard; Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Attorney Ed Buchanan were also present. Visitors attending were Jeff Sharp & Brenda Sharp, Linnea Dix, Bruce Hart and Lisa Johnson.

Mayor Marshall asked for an acting Mayor due to him joining via zoom. Mike Huseby called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm. Diane moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk Haas seconded; motion carried.

Lisa Johnson commented on the progress of the LaGrange Heritage Square over the years and stated how much she enjoys having an office in the building. She thanked the council and staff for their continuing support and improvements to the building.

Mike Huseby asked for old business. Tracy gave an update on the walk path phase II. He has met with the engineers on the final touches for the design phase. The project is still planned to go out to bid in January for a potential start date in the spring. Tracy also gave an update on the LaGrange Heritage Square, town hall and town shop networking and security. Everything seems to be working well. We still need to get the LHS door system renewed and are working with a company for more information.

Mike Huseby asked for new business. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Diane moved to change the meeting time from 7pm to 6pm beginning December through April. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Cathy stated this is Marisa Johnson's last term on the lodging tax board and the council will need to appoint a new person by end of December. She also stated the Goshen County Economic Development Infrastructure Grant Application was submitted for additional funds to help with the towns matching portion for the Walk Path Phase II Project. Tracy discussed the town ordinances focusing on the boundary permit and the length of time provided to complete the project. Tracy provided the quote for the updates to the telemetry system. Kirk moved to approve the quote by Timber Line Electric and Control Corporation in the amount of \$12,028.00. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Tracy stated the lawn mower will need replaced for next summer and there are not very many available. He requested approval to get one ordered as it could be next August before we would receive it. Kirk moved to approve the purchase of a lawn mower in the amount of \$19,620.00. Diane seconded; motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to pay the bills; Diane seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to adjourn at 8:25pm.

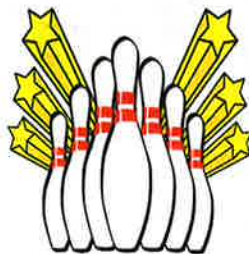
