Minutes from May Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 13th 2021 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby, Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas; Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were present. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. Visitors attending were Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Linnea Dix and David Norwood.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm. Diane moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. There was no old business.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mark congratulated Diane Humphrey and Mike Meysenburg for being re-elected as councilmembers. After brief discussion of the fiscal year 21-22 budget, Kirk moved to approve the second reading of Budget Ordinance #145. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Tracy gave an update on the Water Commission meeting for the second phase of the water study. Mike Huseby made a motion to move the July regular town council meeting to July 15th at 6:00pm to coordinate with the next water study meeting. Diane seconded; motion carried. Cathy and Tracy gave updates on the progress of the walk path project. There were no other clerk or public works comments. Mayor Marshall gave an update on the LaGrange Mini Fair and the breakfast expectations. Kirk moved to pay the bills; Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Diane moved to adjourn at 8:17pm.
