### Minutes from May Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 12<sup>th</sup> 2022 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Mike Meysenburg, Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan was present. Visitors attending were Linnea Dix, Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Mike Vinton, Sheridan Pragnell, Tim Eisenhauer from Baker & Associates and Tyler Isom from Paul Reed Construction.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:02pm. Diane Humphrey moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tim Eisenhauer from Baker & Associates discussed the Walk Path phase II bid opening. After explanation of bid documents, Tim gave his recommendation to accept the bid from Paul Reed construction. Mike Huseby moved to accept the bid from Paul Reed Construction. Diane seconded; motion carried. Visitor Tyler Isom from Paul Reed Construction introduced himself and told the council if they had any concerns feel free to contact him directly. The fiscal year 22-23 budget was discussed, Kirk made a motion to approve the second reading of Ordinance #146 fiscal year 22-23 budget. Mike Meysenburg seconded motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Tracy discussed multiple items with no motions made. Kirk moved to approve the water ordinance first reading to increase water rates \$4, sewer ordinance first reading to increase sewer rates \$3 and the garbage ordinance first reading to increase garbage rates \$3. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to pay the bills; Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:20pm.
