Minutes from February Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on February 14th 2019 at 6:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Ben Cline, Mike Meysenburg and Mike Huseby. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard; Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. Visitor attending was Sherriff Cory Fleenor.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm. Ben Cline moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried.

Sherriff Fleenor came to meet the town council and the town council voiced their concerns for the policing in town. Sherriff Fleenor stressed his concern and stated he would do what he could with the resources he has.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mike Huseby moved to approve a three year lease agreement for The Oak Group, LLC. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Ben Cline gave an update on the Goshen County Economic Development community meeting. Ben moved to apply for the Goshen County Recreation Grant for new fitness equipment and repairs to playground equipment. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried. The state consensus funds were discussed as well as future projects. Mike Huseby moved to reallocate the street funds into the sewer funds for the use of the lagoon project. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. The council also stated they would like Tracy to ask DEQ to attend a council meeting and explain their water and sewer master plan option. Clerk & public works questions were discussed. No motions were made. Ben moved to pay the bills, Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to adjourn at 8:08pm.

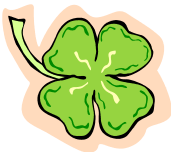

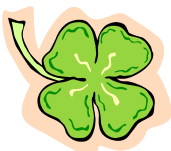
