Minutes from October Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on October 5th 2021 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby, Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas; Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard; and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. Visitors attending were Jeff Sharp, Linnea Dix, Leo Urbanek, Matt Hutt and Aaron Raines.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:08 pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk Haas seconded; motion carried.

Matt Hutt and Aaron Raines with the Western Nebraska Bicycling Club came to talk to the community about the bike race they are having on June 25th 2022. It will be a 160-mile race and they will be coming through LaGrange. They requested an area for the riders to rest, get refreshments and snacks. They anticipate 250 riders. The council discussed the LaGrange Mini Fair is the same day and feel the route the racers will take will not interfere with Mini Fair. Cathy will stay in contact with Matt and Aaron to coordinate the race and Mini Fair activities to benefit both parties.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave an update on the walk path phase II. The project will most likely go out for bid after January for potential start date in the spring. The LaGrange Heritage Square technology issues were discussed. The suites will each have their own internet security and will continue to be hard wired. The door system is still in question and we are working on finding a newer system as the old system can no longer be updated.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mike Huseby moved to approve Resolution 2-21 Amending Budget FY 20-21. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Tracy reminded the council of the meeting Thursday in Cheyenne to choose the engineer for the Phase II Water Study. He stated he had met with both engineers interested in the project and gave further information on the discussions he had with both parties. Cathy discussed the dog complaints she has received. She stated this year has been excessive in the complaints and she will be giving owners a copy of the dog ordinance as they begin renewing their licenses. Cathy also stated the funds from the insurance claim for the community building were received. Diane will talk to the community building board about repayment for the furnace and a maintenance program. Mike Meysenburg moved to pay the bills; Kirk seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to adjourn at 8:44pm.
