Minutes from September Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on September 14th 2017 at 7:00pm. Present were; Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Mike Meysenburg and Ben Cline. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan and Councilman Mike Huseby were absent. There were no visitors attending.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Joel moved to approve the minutes as read. Ben seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. After discussion, Joel moved to approve the first reading of ordinance #65 Animal Control-Dogs. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Joel moved to approve the sewer tap permit and the water tap permit for Bruce Kelley at property location Lot 5 Block 27 Original Town. Ben seconded, motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed, no motions were made. Ben moved to pay the bills, Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Ben moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:15pm.
