## Minutes from August Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 9<sup>th</sup> 2018 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Ben Cline and Mike Huseby. Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell was also present. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard, Councilman Mike Meysenburg, and Attorney Ed Buchanan were absent. There were no visitors attending

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:07pm. Mike Huseby moved to approve the minutes as read. Ben seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mark stated that the flooring in the Suite 123 of the LHS building needs to be replaced. He will get quotes. The current quote received was rejected due to cost. The sidewalk project was discussed and quotes will be gathered. Mike Huseby moved to pay the bills, Ben seconded, motion carried. Ben moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:45pm.

## Minutes from Special Council Meeting

Minutes of the Special Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 22<sup>nd</sup> 2019 at 7:00pm for the purpose of the award of the Fire Truck bid. Present were Mayor Mark Marshall, Councilman Kirk Haas, Mike Huseby, Ben Cline and Mike Meysenburg. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were also present. Visitors attending were Deb and Jeff Sharp.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:07pm. Tracy discussed the project phases and went over the bid amounts. There were five packets requested and two bids returned. The bids were from Deep South Fire Trucks in the amount of \$362,572 and Front Range Fire Apparatus in the amount of \$469,253 After discussion, Kirk moved to award the bid to Deep South Fire Trucks in the amount of \$362,572 upon USDA and SLIB bid approvals. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried unanimously. Mike Meysenburg moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:23pm.
