Minutes from August Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 13th 2020 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Kirk Haas, Mike Meysenburg, Mike Huseby and Diane Humphrey; Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. Visitors attending were Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Mark Willoughby and Jennifer Burns.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm. Kirk moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried.

Jennifer Burns came to introduce herself as a candidate for House District 10.

Mark Willoughby came to ask the council for suggestions on how to get his trailer removed and or demolished by the end of August. After discussion, the council stated they will need to address some questions with legal counsel and would get back to Mark as soon as possible.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. The sidewalk project is complete. The lagoon project is coming along well and should be complete by October. There is no update on the fire truck at this time.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. The lease for Visionary is complete. Clerk & public works questions were discussed. Cathy stated there are several ordinances that may need to be updated and potentially added to the town code. She stated we will be addressing those in the next few meetings. She also stated the Smart Start Preschool will be open again this year and hopes to add an after-school program. Tracy stated the divers for the water tank will be here the end of August. He also stated he needs several hours to keep his waste water certification active. He plans to get those hours the end of this month or next. Tracy presented a trailer description to the council and stated the old trailer is no longer operable for long distances. Kirk moved to purchase a new trailer not to exceed \$6500. Diane seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to go into executive session at 8:13pm for the purpose of possible litigation. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to resume the public meeting at 9:05pm. Diane seconded motion carried. Kirk moved to pay the bills; Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourn at 9:07pm.
