Minutes from August Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 10th 2023 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Kirk Haas, Mike Meysenburg, Diane Humphrey and Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard. Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Attorney Lena Moeller were absent due to illness. There were several visitors attending.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Kirk moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Diane Humphrey requested the recording of last meeting to be transcribed so the council could address the concerns made by Jenny Pragnell.

Peggy Oedekoven came to address the chicken ordinance. She read a statement she had written and requested the ordinance be readdressed. After further discussion and public comment, the council will provide a new ordinance referring to chickens at the September council meeting for consideration. Phillip and Lora Gomes came to request permission to close main street from B&V café to the post office park from the hours of 7pm – 9pm on Saturdays beginning August 19th 2023 until October 28th 2023 for line dancing. Diane moved to approve their request. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Kirk gave an update on the grant projects. There will be a pre-construction meeting at 10am tomorrow for the walk path project. The water well will be drilled in the next couple weeks and the recreation equipment will be installed after the walk path is complete. Kirk stated Tracy Pragnell is watching two auctions for speed signs that are the same as our current sign and hopes we will be able to purchase one of them.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mike moved to approve Resolution #4-23 Investment Policy. Diane seconded; Kirk abstained; motion carried. Kirk moved to table the Budget Amendment Resolution for the September meeting. Diane seconded; motion carried. Clerk questions and comments were discussed. Cathy read a statement to the Goshen County School Board on education of the US Constitution. Kirk moved to send the letter as read to the School Board. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to add a page to the town website for the cemetery contact information per request from Jamie Beightol, secretary of cemetery board. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Cathy also stated the State Auditor Office is offering an online training for the Public Officer Training on August 23rd 2023 and we could host at the town hall for anyone interested in attending. The training is for all public office officials. Diane moved to pay the bills. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:38pm.

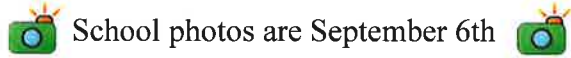
