Minutes from May Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 9th 2024 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Kirk Haas, Mike Huseby and Mike Meysenburg. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard was also present. Councilmember Diane Humphrey; Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell and Attorney, Lena Moeller were absent. Visitors attending were; Linnea Dix, Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Peggy Oedekoven, Robin Boyd, and Justin Sorrick.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:03pm. Kirk moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Cathy gave quick updates on the water study and shop project. Kirk moved to approve the second reading of FY 24-25 Budget Ordinance #148 with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. This will include an increase in water rates by \$4 and sewer rates by \$2 monthly.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Cathy stated she added the arena rates discussed at the last council meeting to the town policy. Kirk moved to approve the town policies with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Cathy gave an update on the town website and asked the council about business rates for the website. Mike Meysenburg made a motion to charge \$20/year for home page advertising for local businesses. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to pay the bills. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:13pm.
