Minutes from August Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on August 8th 2024 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall and Councilmembers Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas. Councilmember Mike Huseby joined via zoom. Councilmember Mike Meysenburg was absent. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were present. Visitors attending were; Peggy Oedekoven, Robin Boyd, Abbey Boyd, Robert Goodall, Jeff Sharp, Linnea Dix, Mike Vinton and Coby Romig.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:03pm. Diane Humphrey moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk Haas seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for public comments. Mike Vinton asked the council if he could work at the arena cleaning up a few things, possibly painting and leveling posts. Since Diane Humphrey is a member of the mini fair board, she recused herself from the meeting; Kirk moved for Mike Vinton to proceed as long as the mini fair board approves also. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy stated he has reviewed the final draft of the water study II project, made corrections and sent it back to AVI Engineering. He is currently waiting for the completed final draft. Tracy also stated the project is getting too close to the deadline to proceed this year. There will need to be a public meeting and having a few extra months will be beneficial to the town. We will need to apply next year for funding if the council chooses to continue with construction. Tracy went on to discuss the public works facility project, introducing Coby Romig of JEO Consulting. Coby stated, unfortunately, all the bids were significantly over the town budget. Therefore, their recommendation for the town is to reject all bids and re-bid the project. He stated this will level the playing field for all bidders to come back to the table with competitive bids. Kirk Haas moved to reject all bids for the public works faciality. Diane seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to re-bid the public works facility project. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Clerk & public works questions were discussed, no motions were made. Cathy stated the Wyrulec bill is \$3,224.47. Kirk moved to pay the bills. Diane seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:27pm.

There will be a charge to pick up tires, \$3.00 a piece.




