Minutes from October Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on October 10th 2024 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby and Mike Meysenburg. Councilmember Kirk Haas and Diane Humphrey were absent. Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell and Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard were present. Visitors attending were: Peggy Oedekoven, Jeff Sharp and Ray Young.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:03pm. Mike Huseby moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mayor Marshall stated Scott Prusia could not attend and he explained the lodging tax handouts he was given.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave updates on the water study and public works facility project.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Cathy and Tracy updated the council on the cybersecurity meeting. Cathy recommended the 1-hour workshop for the council and will schedule the training. She also stated the town policies and ordinances will need to be addressed for annual review at the next meeting. Clerk questions were discussed, no motions were made. Public Works questions were discussed. Mike Huseby made a motion to approve water permits for locations of Block 16 Lot 3 Original Town; Block 16 Lot 4 Original Town; Block 16 Lot 7 Original Town; Block 16 Lot 5 Original Town; Block 32 Lot 6 Griffins Addition (Fire Suppression) Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby made a motion to approve sewer permits for locations of Block 16 Lot 5 Original Town and Block 32 Lot 6 Griffins Addition. Mike Meysenburg seconded motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to pay the bills. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:07pm.

LaGrange Elementary School News...



Every Tuesday at 2:30-3:30 the students practice for their Christmas Musical. That will be held on December 5th.


LaGrange Elementary made these for Constitution Day.






Thank You Brandy Evans! LaGrange Elementary Students learned how to use a circuit board, alligator clips and anything that conducts electricity to create a computer keyboard. It's called a MakeyMakey. In the pictures they are using bananas to play a piano on the computer. The students found objects in the classroom that conduct electricity, like erasers, paperclips, thumbtacks, pencil lead, themselves, etc. They then learned how to create an electrical loop with those objects. Once the loop is created the circuit board uses those objects as keystrokes on the computer.


They also played a guitar with thumbtacks and paperclips. This utilized their computer programing skills they learned in previous years with drag and drop block coding.
