Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave updates on the water study and public works facility project.


There will be <u>NO Unity meeting in December</u>. <u>Next Meeting will be January 13, 7 pm.</u>
