Minutes from December Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on December 12th 2024 at 6:00pm. Present were: Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Diane Humphrey, Kirk Haas and Mike Meysenburg. Mayor Mark Marshall was absent. Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell and Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard were present. Visitors attending were: Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Phil & Lora Gomes, Jim & Cullene Clayton and Micah Gomes.

Acting Mayor Kirk Haas called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Mike Huseby moved to approve the minutes as read. Diane seconded; motion carried.

Phil & Lora Gomes came to discuss concerns about signs on the highway and proposed a resolution suggesting all signs be placed on one display. They also voiced concerns about the time it takes for the patrolman to respond to a call. After discussion, no motions were made.

Acting Mayor Haas asked for old business. Tracy gave updates on the Level II Water Study and public works facility project. The state needs to hold a public hearing on the water study and requested January 16th or 30th at 11:00. The council agreed on the 16th. The public hearing date and time will be advertised. This will be the final phase of the Level II Water Study. The shop is in progress and moving along smoothly at this point. The building package should be here the week of the 23rd.

Acting Mayor Haas asked for new business. Cathy stated two LHS renters' contracts are coming due January 1, 2025. Mike Huseby proposed a 10cent per square foot increase and stated he has spoken to the tenants. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the 10cent increase per square foot. Diane seconded; motion carried. LHS rental space is set at 75cents per square foot. Cathy stated she has made changes to the policy per the previous council meeting. After further discussion she will make additions to the policy for the next council meeting. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Cathy stated she is still trying to work with EWC on the computers in the computer lab. The town website was discussed. No motions were made. Cathy stated she will be on vacation January 2nd till January 9th. She will have policy additions; resolutions and any proposed ordinance changes ready for the January meeting. Tracy stated he will be taking vacation the week of December 23rd till December 30th. Diane mentioned this is her last term on the Lodging Tax Board and the council needs to start looking for a replacement. She has been on the board for two terms and they only allow two terms per board member. Mike Huseby moved to change the January meeting date to the 16th at 6:00pm. Diane seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to pay the bills. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:44pm.
