Minutes from January Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on January 16th 2025 at 6:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Diane Humphrey, Kirk Haas and Mike Meysenburg; Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell and Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard. Visitors attending were: Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Peggy Oedekoven and Linnea Dix.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. Diane moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. He gave an update on the public hearing on the water study. Mike Huseby made a motion to continue with the construction phase of the project. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mayor Marshall gave an update on the public works facility project. The construction will be on hold for 60 days due to weather and will be reassessed after 30 days. Ordinances, policies and budget were discussed no motions were made. Budget items including utility rate increases will be further discussed at the next council meeting as well as the continued discussion on ordinances and policies.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Diane moved to approve resolution #1-25 Investment Policy. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to approve Complaint Form and Public Records Request Form. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Cathy stated she is still visiting with EWC on the computers in the computer lab. She reminded everyone to ask around for a volunteer for the Lodging Tax Board. Vista Beam requested a letter of support for a grant to better services in LaGrange. Mayor Marshall will sign the letter. Tracy stated the custodian positions are opening and the town will advertise for 30 days and applications can be picked up at the town hall. Mark Marshall stated he will call an executive session for the purpose of personnel wages on February 13th at 5:30 pm prior to the regular council meeting at 6:00 pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to pay the bills. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:21pm.
