#### Minutes from March Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on March 13<sup>th</sup> 2025 at 6:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Kirk Haas, Diane Humphrey and Mike Meysenburg; and Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard. Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell was absent. Visitors attending were: Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Curt & Cheryl Grandstaff, Peggy Oedekoven, Linnea Dix, Esther Davis, Daisy Justus, and Tammy Dirienzo.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:06pm. Kirk moved to approve the minutes as read. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Peggy Oedekoven came to request removing the number of chickens allowed from the ordinance. After a lengthy discussion, no motions were made.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. He and Kirk gave updates on the water project and the public works facility. Cathy discussed budget briefly. Mark tabled the RV discussion.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Mike Huseby moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #84- Repealing Ordinance #50-Application for Boundary Permit. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to approve Resolution #2-25 An increase to water rates. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve Resolution #3-25 An increase to waste water rates. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Diane moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance#149 -Budget FY 25-26. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to approve the water permit and sewer permit for location lot 1, block 13, Original town address 100 C Street. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Cathy stated the South Goshen Conservation District is having the Hazardous Waste Collection Day on April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2025. Mike Meysenburg moved to provide \$100 to help with the program. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Diane moved to pay the bills. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25pm.
